Write a character diary for a character of your choice. Your diary must include at least five entries and should reflect events that happen throughout the story. The diary entries should demonstrate the character reflecting on these events and how they were affected.

Write a one-page "pitch" to a movie producer explaining why the story would make a great movie. (4-5 Paragraphs minimum font size max 12)

Write a poem about an idea, character, concept, or conflict presented in your book. Make sure it has a title.

Identify the main problem or conflict in the story. Explain how you would have responded if you were in that same situation and why. (3 Paragraphs minimum)
